WINE INDUSTRY SAFETY SUGGESTION

During the November and subsequent earthquakes, Marlborough Lines have found a number of spans of power lines that have sagged lower than previous measurements.

THESE WERE ACROSS ROADWAYS OR IN PUBLIC PLACES

- Low voltage lines over paddocks need to be at least 5.0m above ground and 5.5m over access tracks (NZECP 34:2001).
- Corresponding ground clearances for HV lines are 5.5m over paddocks and 6.5m over access tracks.
- The road legal vehicle height limit is 4.25m so there is not a lot of clearance if power lines have sagged.


As part of a pre-harvesting risk review, if any span of power line is thought to be lower than previous please ask your lines company to measure it.
